Introduction

- SPENVIS allows students to perform easily rapid analyses of the space environment and its effects on spacecrafts components.
- In order to facilitate and promote the use of SPENVIS in educational programs, specific student accounts have been introduced.



Why asking for student accounts?

- You can manage those student accounts yourself, for example reset passwords and clear projects
- You can also reuse these accounts for other projects

Today 14 teachers manage
in total 285 student accounts

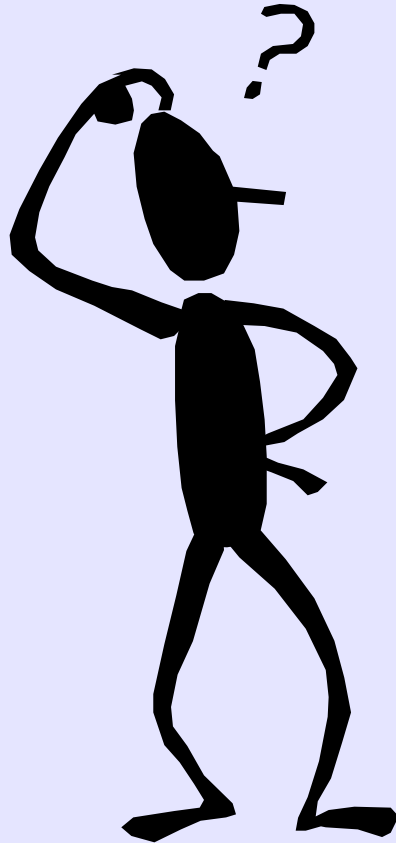


Necessary information
